
Edward Ang — Catechist St. Augustine Church







Confirmation Preparation Class October 20 & 21, 2023 for Adults

This format is offered to catechized adults (18 years or older) who need preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.



Role of the Parish

Since sacramental preparation is formation, we expect candidates to have active participation in their parish community. To ensure that this takes place outside the class, the following involvement of the parish with the candidate for Confirmation is expected:

- Conduct a preliminary interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or his representative from the parish staff).
- ⇒ Provide the candidate with a parish sponsor * who shall maintain weekly contact with the candidate throughout the preparation time.
 ⇒ Secure from the candidate all documents
- Baptismal Certificate.

 ⇒ Conduct an exit interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or assigned personnel) for the

place, date of the celebration of the Sacrament. If
the Sacrament will be celebrated at St Mary's
Cathedral, send a parish representative to attend
the ceremony in support of the candidate.

After the ceremony, provide a Confirmation certificate to the newly confirmed and record the sacrament received in the parish Confirmation register. The Parish Sponsor represents the parish community. The Parish Sponsor acts as a companion who guides, prays with and encourages the candidate to live out the Christian life of a disciple in the parish community.

Role of the Candidate:

Attend both interviews with the Pastor or his representative.

- Provide sacramental information on their Baptism and first Eucharist to the parish contact.
- Attend both sessions for catechetical formation at the Archdiscesan Pastoral Center
- Choose a sponsor who is at least 16 years of age, a practicing Catholic and fully initiated (had received Baptism. Confirmation and Eucharist)

The Sacrament may also be received at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption at Pentecost, November 26, at the 5:00pm Mass with the Archbishop. The Office of Faith Formation will notify the parish that the candidate has completed the course work.

API Program Overview

The objective of this program is to provide a culturally focused formation of pastoral leaders, both professional staff and volunteer lay, who serve the growing number of Asian Pacific Islander Catholic communities around the United States.

We will look at immigration histories, cultural and religious practices, and Catholic teachings and traditions, from the API perspective. We will also unpack the US Bishops' document, Encountering Christ in Harmony: A Pastoral Response to Our Asian and Pacific Island Brothers and Sisters, to see what practical guidance it offers for those working on the ground with API communities.

Outcomes:Know the immigration history, religious practices, and sociological challenges of <u>API Catholics in the US.</u>

- Have a broad overview of Catholic teachings and theology as well as church history, structure, and doctrine.
- Be able to more effectively understand the needs of API Catholic communities
