ST. AUGUSTINE SPECIAL EDUCATION CATECHIST HONORED BY AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION AND PUBLICATION IN THE PHILIPPINES



Overtaxed and undermanned, many of America's mainstream teachers are at a crossroads. They yearn for time, compassion, and the precious gift of support. It is one of the greatest professions. Yet, although teachers love what they do, extensive deficiencies are likely if their needs remain unheard.

Furthermore, there is one group of widely unrecognized, overlooked, and undervalued educators: **Special Education (Sped) Teachers**.

Audrey Ann B. Bayogos is one of our credentialed Faith Formation Sped Catechists here at St. Augustine.

Aside from being a Special Day Class educator at the Jefferson School District and teaching at John F. Kennedy Elementary School in Daly City, CA, she still finds time to volunteer her

services every Saturday, which she has done since 2020.

Audrey Ann does an excellent job in compassionately preparing students with special needs for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion.

Audrey Ann has successfully prepared a diverse group of students with Individual Education Programs (IEP) ranging from 3rd to 8th grade, who have Autism (ASD); Down Syndrome (DS); Intellectual Disability (ID); Speech and Language Disorder/Disability (SLD) and Global Delayed Disorder/Disability (GDD).

Audrey Ann earned her Master of Arts degree in Special Education from the University of the Philippines in Quezon City and the University of the Visayas in Cebu, Philippines. She earned her Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from the Philippine Normal University in Manila and earned local credentials from the University of California in San Diego, University of Phoenix in Arizona, and the National University in Pleasant Hill.

She brings with her over 28 years of experience in teaching children ages 2-10 years old, as a Sped Therapist/Teacher and a Montessori Early Childhood Educator. She was also a

Consultant and Case Manager for children with special needs.

According to an article found on the Wiley University Services website, "Special education (Sped) teachers have a higher rate of burnout than is found in most other professions."

The various disabilities of Sped students with whom Sped teachers teach, increases the strain associated with the job; yet Audrey Ann's dedication toward her students outweigh the challenges she faces each day.

It is because of this, that she was awarded the **2023 Outstanding Global Special Teacher Award** by an International Organization and Aloysian Publication in the Philippines, last December 2023 and was recently awarded the **2024 Dakilang Filipino Award** as the **Best Outstanding Special Education Specialist** for "teaching students with extensive and support needs."

Please join us in congratulating our Catechist, Audrey Ann B. Bayogos, on these prestigious awards and recognition; and for reaching the pinnacle of excellence in her chosen field.

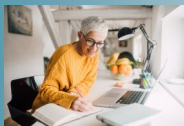

These classes are in-person and candidates are required to attend all the sessions.

This format is offered to catechized adults (16 years or older) who need preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.



Role of the Parish

Since sacramental preparation is formation, we expect candidates to have active participation in their parish community. To ensure that this takes place outside the class, the following involvement of the parish with the candidate for Confirmation is expected:

- ⇒ Conduct a preliminary interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or his representative from the parish staff).
- ⇒ Provide the candidate with a parish sponsor * who shall maintain weekly contact with the candidate throughout the preparation time.
- ⇒ Secure from the candidate all documents necessary for the reception of Confirmation e.g., Baptismal Certificate.
- ⇒ Conduct an exit interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or assigned personnel) for the candidate's final discernment of the Sacrament.
- ⇒ Inform the candidate and sponsor of the time/place, and date of the celebration of the Sacrament. If the Sacrament will be celebrated at St. Mary's Cathedral, send a parish representative to attend the ceremony in support of the candidate.

⇒ After the ceremony, provide a Confirmation certificate to the newly confirmed and record the sacrament received in the parish Confirmation register.

* *The Parish Sponsor represents the parish community. The Parish Sponsor acts as a companion who guides, prays with and encourages the candidate to live out the Christian life of a disciple in the parish community.*

Role of the Candidate:

- ⇒ Attend both interviews with the Pastor or his representative.
- ⇒ Provide sacramental information on their Baptism and First Eucharist to the parish contact.
- ⇒ Attend both sessions for catechetical formation at the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center
- ⇒ Choose a sponsor who is at least 16 years of age, a practicing Catholic, and fully initiated (had received Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist)



The Office of Faith Formation prepares catechized adults for the Sacrament of Confirmation in a series of two sessions. **Candidates are required to attend both sessions.**

Session One: Friday, April 19, 6:00 to 8:30 p.m.

Session Two: Saturday, April 20, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Classes are offered in English and Spanish.

Cost: \$60.00 per person. This covers the cost of materials, supplies, and refreshments.



When can the Sacrament of Confirmation be received?

After the catechetical preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Sacrament may be received in the parish when the Archbishop or Bishop comes to the parish to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with the faith community. **The Sacrament may also be received at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption on May 25, 2024, at the 5:30 PM Mass with the Archbishop.**

The Office of Faith Formation will notify the parish that the candidate has completed the coursework.

Biografía: Felicitas Brugo Onetti es la Coordinadora de Educación y Divulgación contra la Trata de Personas en el Departamento de Servicios de Migración y Refugiados de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos. Nacida en Buenos Aires, Argentina, Felicitas siempre se sintió atraída por trabajar con poblaciones inmigrantes. Se ofreció como voluntaria extensamente con familias migrantes y refugiadas guatemaltecas y mexicanas mientras crecía en Miami, Florida y asistió a varios viajes misioneros mientras obtenía su título de trabajo social en la Universidad Católica de América en Washington, DC. Durante sus estudios académicos, trabajó estrechamente como trabajadora social escolar, brindando acceso a servicios, recursos y tratamiento a niños migrantes y familias que buscan refugio en los Estados Unidos.

Uno de los principales proyectos en los que se centra es el [Movimiento Amistad](#), una iniciativa inspirada en los captivos a bordo del barco de esclavitud [Amistad](#) que se rebelaron y ganaron su libertad. La iniciativa trabaja para empoderar a las poblaciones inmigrantes en comunidades en riesgo para evitar que sean víctimas de la trata de personas. Junto con el [Programa Conviértete en Pastor](#), que trabaja para educar a sacerdotes, monjas, religiosos laicos y otros miembros de la iglesia sobre la educación y los recursos sobre la trata de personas, Felicitas está trabajando para recrear y expandir estos programas para poblaciones vulnerables como hispanos/latinos, nativos americanos, nativos de Alaska, isleños del Pacífico y personas negras para abordar mejor las necesidades de cada comunidad única.
