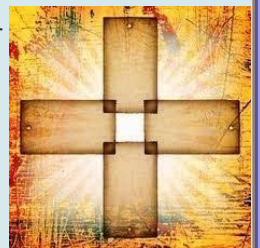

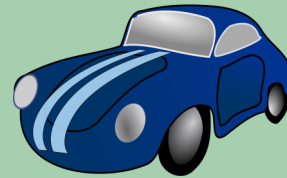

Pope Francis invites the whole Church to participate in the next phase of the Synod on Synodality through engagement sessions that will inform the upcoming Synod of Bishops on Synodality in October 2024. Each county will host a session where parishioners can participate in reflections and discussions designed to help shape the Church's understanding of herself and her mission of evangelization and forming disciples. Results will be summarized and shared with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), who will use the information collected to prepare a national report for the Synod leaders at the Vatican. Rite of Election

The Church makes its "election," that is, **the choice and admission of those catechumens who have the dispositions that make them fit to take part, at the next major celebration, in the sacraments of initiation** . They then embark on a Period of Purification and Enlightenment, marking the culmination of their rigorous preparation for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Over the subsequent five Sundays of Lent, they undergo three scrutinies, rituals aimed at introspection and repentance, alongside the recitations of the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. This phase culminates in the joyful reception of the Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter Vigil celebration.

These classes are in-person and candidates are required to attend all the sessions.

This format is offered to catechized adults (16 years or older) who need preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.



Role of the Parish

Since sacramental preparation is formation, we expect candidates to have active participation in their parish community. To ensure that this takes place outside the class, the following involvement of the parish with the candidate for Confirmation is expected:

- ⇒ Conduct a preliminary interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or his representative from the parish staff).
- ⇒ Provide the candidate with a parish sponsor * who shall maintain weekly contact with the candidate throughout the preparation time.
- ⇒ Secure from the candidate all documents necessary for the reception of Confirmation e.g., Baptismal Certificate.
- ⇒ Conduct an exit interview with the candidate (to be done by the Pastor or assigned personnel) for the candidate's final discernment of the Sacrament.
- ⇒ Inform the candidate and sponsor of the time/place, and date of the celebration of the Sacrament. If the Sacrament will be celebrated at St. Mary's Cathedral, send a parish representative to attend the ceremony in support of the candidate.

⇒ After the ceremony, provide a Confirmation certificate to the newly confirmed and record the sacrament received in the parish Confirmation register.

* *The Parish Sponsor represents the parish community. The Parish Sponsor acts as a companion who guides, prays with and encourages the candidate to live out the Christian life of a disciple in the parish community.*

Role of the Candidate:

- ⇒ Attend both interviews with the Pastor or his representative.
- ⇒ Provide sacramental information on their Baptism and First Eucharist to the parish contact.
- ⇒ Attend both sessions for catechetical formation at the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center
- ⇒ Choose a sponsor who is at least 16 years of age, a practicing Catholic, and fully initiated (had received Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist)



The Office of Faith Formation prepares catechized adults for the Sacrament of Confirmation in a series of two sessions. **Candidates are required to attend both sessions.**

Session Two: Saturday, April 20, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Cost: \$60.00 per person. This covers the cost of materials, supplies, and refreshments.



When can the Sacrament of Confirmation be received?

After the catechetical preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Sacrament may be received in the parish when the Archbishop or Bishop comes to the parish to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with the faith community. **The Sacrament may also be received at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption on May 25, 2024, at the 5:30 PM Mass with the Archbishop.**

The Office of Faith Formation will notify the parish that the candidate has completed the coursework.
